FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

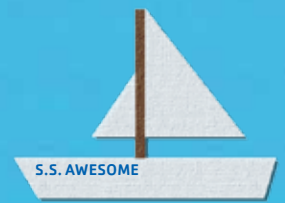

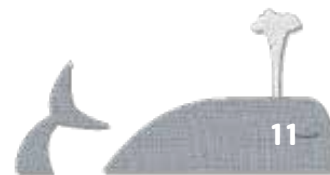
